

**NOTICE OF REMOTE PUBLIC INFORMATION HEARING
FOR AIR QUALITY CONSTRUCTION PERMIT APPLICATION #3292-M1
FOR C&C SERVICES, LLC.**

Due to COVID-19, the City of Albuquerque Environmental Health Department Air Quality Program (Program) is conducting public information hearings **remotely only** via a public Zoom video conference for air quality construction permit applications in response to the New Mexico Governor's declaration of a Public Health Emergency and ban on large public gatherings. The hearing via public Zoom video conference is held **remotely only** in order to protect public health, safety and welfare while ensuring the continued opportunity of public engagement in public processes.

A Public Information Hearing (hearing) will be held **remotely only** via a public Zoom video conference to provide information and answer questions regarding the Air Quality Construction Permit Application #3292-M1 for C&C Services, LLC. The hearing will occur **remotely only** on November 19, 2020 starting at 6:00 pm and ending no later than 8:00 pm. The Hearing Officer may end the public information hearing before 8 pm depending on the number of participants who wish to speak. A Spanish interpreter will be available at the November 19, 2020 remote hearing. This notice provides a summary of this proposed activity and explains the reason for the hearing. The Air Quality Program of the City of Albuquerque Environmental Health Department has not yet made a final decision on the application.

Participants are invited to attend the hearing and are able to fully participate in the hearing through their smart phone, tablet or computer. Instructions for public comment at the remote hearing:

At the Public Information Hearing, the Hearing Officer will ask who would like to speak, please use the icon in Zoom to raise your "hand." You will be called in the order that your "hand" was raised.

Public participants will be asked by the Zoom moderator to provide their name, email and organization. Each participant will standby in the Zoom virtual waiting room. If the participant wishes to provide public comment, the Zoom moderator will move them from the waiting room and into the meeting. Once in the Zoom meeting room, the participants must mute themselves. The Zoom moderator will unmute the participant at the time their name is called to provide public comment.

The time available for each individual to provide public comment may be limited by the Hearing Officer, depending on the number of participants that signed up to participate. Your time will start when you begin speaking and the Hearing Officer will let you know when your time has concluded. The existing facility (Facility) is a portable construction material crushing and screening facility. The existing permit includes one (1) 300 ton per hour portable concrete, asphalt, and gravel crushing and screening unit, powered by one (1) 499 hp diesel-fired generator set. The Facility location is 2901 Second Street SW, Albuquerque, NM 87105. The applicant's name is C&C Services, LLC and the applicant's address is 2901 Second Street SW, Albuquerque, NM 87105. The application requests to modify the existing air quality construction permit #3292 by:

1. Modifying all Process Equipment Unit descriptions to reflect the equipment that is onsite and differentiating between multiple pieces of equipment that are similar;
2. Updating the emissions from all emission units using industry-specific and unit-specific emission factors, and according to the New Source Performance Standards (NSPS);
3. Modifying the operating hours for the site to 12 hours/day, Monday through Saturday, and 52 weeks/yr;
4. Relocating some of the equipment, drop points, and storage piles at the facility;
5. Moving the north side concrete storage pile to the side of the property; and,
6. Moving the crusher/engine and screen from the north side of the property to the new land south of their current location.

The Program has reviewed the air quality dispersion modeling for this Facility. The Program's review indicates that the Facility's air emissions will meet the air quality standards for Nitrogen Oxides (NO_x), Carbon Monoxide (CO), Sulfur Oxides (SO_x), Particulate Matter <10 microns (PM-10), and Particulate Matter <2.5 microns (PM-2.5). In regards to the ozone air quality standard, ozone is normally only modeled for regional compliance demonstrations and does not need to be modeled for air quality permits, subject to certain exceptions not applicable here. Prior to making a final decision on the application, the Program will consider all relevant public comments and make any necessary final evaluations of the estimated emission rates for this Facility to assess compliance with ambient air quality requirements and standards. The number of the proposed permit, if issued, will be **#3292-M1**.

The proposed air contaminants maximum allowable emissions from this facility have been estimated to be:

*These columns factor in the Facility's operational limits that the permit would impose, if issued.

The operating schedules and operating parameters for this Facility will be:

1. Operating hours: 7 AM to 7 PM, Monday through Saturday, not to exceed 3744 hours of operation per year;
2. Throughput limits:
 - a) Hourly limit of 300 tons
 - b) Annual limit of 1,123,200 tons
3. Haul road traffic shall not exceed 53 trucks per day;
4. Setbacks:
 - a) Working piles must remain at least 20 feet from the eastern and western fences
 - b) The crusher, screen and engine must remain at least 60 feet away from the eastern and western fences and 175 feet away from the southern fence
5. Working piles, crusher, screen and conveyor emissions shall be controlled by the application of water;
6. The engine shall be operated and maintained to achieve federal emission standards;
7. A fence or some other barrier restricts access to the property; and,
8. The unpaved haul road shall be controlled with gravel and millings and the application of water.

At the hearing, the Program staff will be available to answer questions regarding the review process for air quality permit applications in general, and the C&C Services, LLC application specifically. The Program has requested that the applicant or its representative(s) attend to answer questions. The public will have a reasonable opportunity to voice concerns and submit data or arguments regarding the application, whether orally or in writing. Those who wish to speak at the November 19, 2020 remote hearing should raise their hand when asked by the Hearing Officer during the remote hearing. A Hearing Officer will direct the

proceedings and is authorized to limit the length of testimony, if necessary, so that all members of the public who wish to speak will have an opportunity to do so.

After the remote hearing, the Program staff will evaluate the entire application file before making a decision on the application. This includes, but is not limited to, public comments received and relevant testimony presented at the hearing. All persons who have previously commented on this application and who have also provided contact information to the Program, will be provided notice of the Program's decision.
