

PUBLIC NOTICE

Construction Permit for Mountain States Constructors

Mountain States Constructors, Inc. has submitted an air quality construction permit application to the Air Quality Program (Program) of the City of Albuquerque Environmental Health Department for a new permit. The permit is for a 400 tons/hr hot mix asphalt plant (HMA) to be located at the southwest corner of Murry Rd. SE and Broadway Blvd. SE (Site Coordinates **UTMN 3,874,660m UTME 349,170m**) in Albuquerque, New Mexico. The owner of this facility is Mountain States Constructors, Inc., 3601 Pan America Frwy. NE, Suite #111, Albuquerque, NM 87107. This application file has been assigned Construction Permit #3291.

The facility is a HMA production plant, with aggregate and recycled asphalt products (RAP) and asphalt cement handling. The proposed facility will consist of one (1) hot mix drum, one (1) hot mix drum baghouse, five (5) cold feed bins, four (4) cold feed conveyors, one (1) cold feed scalping screen, one (1) cold feed pug mill, one (1) mineral filler silo, two (2) HMA RAP bins, three (3) HMA RAP conveyors, one (1) HMA RAP screen, one (1) HMA incline conveyor, six (6) HMA silos, two (2) HMA asphalt cement storage tanks, one (1) fuel oil fired hot oil heater, two (2) RAP crusher plant feeders, two (2) RAP crusher plant crushers, eight (8) RAP crusher plant conveyors, one (1) RAP crusher plant surge bin, one (1) RAP crusher plant screen, one (1) HMA plant process engine, one (1) HMA plant backup engine, one (1) RAP plant process engine, plant haul roads and aggregate/RAP storage piles.

The maximum air pollution emissions to the atmosphere from this facility have been estimated to be:

Carbon Monoxide (CO) – 66.14 pounds per hour (lbs/hr) – 88.00 tons per year (tpy), Nitrogen Oxides (NOx) – 54.99 lbs/hr – 91.90 tpy, Sulfur Oxides (SOx) – 24.00 lbs/hr – 28.90 tpy, Total Suspended Particulates (TSP) – 26.91 lb/hr – 29.50 tpy, 10 Micron Particulate Matter (PM₁₀) – 15.35 lb/hr – 17.38 tpy, 2.5 Micron Particulate Matter (PM_{2.5}) – 11.83 lb/hr – 14.23 tpy, Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) – 22.41 lb/hr – 26.89 tpy, Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs) – 4.72 tpy

A copy of the permit application is available for inspection by the public at the Program offices. Interested persons may submit written comments and evidence, request a public information hearing, or both on the permit application to the Program. Comments will be accepted and considered if postmarked by the end of the public comment period on January 26, 2017. Formal action on the application will be reserved pending receipt and analysis of any additional details or information developed during the public comment period.

The Program shall hold a Public Information Hearing pursuant to 20.11.41.15 NMAC if the Director determines there is significant public interest and a significant air quality issue is involved.

The Program expects to issue, issue subject to conditions, or deny this application before March 21, 2017. Any person who does not participate in the permitting action will not receive notification of the Program's decision regarding the proposed permit, unless the person has delivered a written request for notice to the Program.
