AIR QUALITY ACID RAIN PERMIT RENEWAL FOR THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT

The City of Albuquerque Solid Waste Management Department has submitted an air quality Title V permit renewal application for the Cerro Colorado Landfill, to the Air Quality Program (Program) of the City of Albuquerque Environmental Health Department. The application was received by the Program on June 9, 2017. The owner of the facility is the City of Albuquerque Solid Waste Management Department, 4600 Edith Blvd NE, Albuquerque, NM 87107. The facility, Cerro Colorado Landfill, is located at 18000 Cerro Colorado Blvd SW, Albuquerque, NM 87121 (UTMZ: 13, UTME: 328950 m, UTMN: 3877730 m) in Bernalillo County, New Mexico. This application file has been assigned **Permit Application #0537-M1-RN1**.

This facility is a Municipal Solid Waste Landfill. It serves the solid waste disposal needs for the City of Albuquerque and Bernalillo County. This landfill is designed to contain 81,300,000 cubic yards of waste total and is anticipated to be in use until the year 2055. Current operating hours of the landfill are from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm, 362 days a year. The main air pollutant emitting facilities are the following: emergency backup and process diesel-fired internal combustion engine, paved and unpaved roads, landfill cells, landfill gas flare, horizontal grinder and screen, site wind erosion and fuel dispensing.

This operating permit application is for a renewal to Title V Operating permit #0537-M1. The renewal includes minor updates and corrections, as well as incorporates two (2) existing and three (3) revised New Source Review (NSR) permits into the Title V permit. The five (5) total NSR permits, which have already been approved, are Permit #1801, #2185, #653-M1-2AR, #1685-M1-1AR, and #17132-3AR.

The five NSR permits were previously presented to the following public notice requirements in 20.11.41, NMAC. The Program's decision to grant or disapprove the permit modification will be based on review of the renewal application received on June 9, 2017, which was deemed complete on August 11, 2017, and Air Quality Control Regulations for Albuquerque/Bernalillo County, as amended.

The proposed air pollution maximum allowable emissions from this facility have been estimated to be: Carbon Monoxide (CO) – 28.2 pounds per hour (lbs/hr) – 116.5 tons per year (tpy), Nitrogen Oxides (NOx) – 12.0 lbs/hr – 32.3 tpy, Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) – 8.96 lbs/hr – 38.7 tpy, NOx+VOC – 1.82 lbs/hr – 2.05 tpy, Sulfur Dioxide (SOX) – 2.52 lbs/hr – 6.74 tpy, Total Suspended Particulate Matter (TSP) – 457.1 lbs/hr – 976.7 tpy, Particulate Matter Less Than 10 Micrometers (PM-10) – 143.5 lbs/hr – 316.1 tpy, Particulate Matter Less Than 2.5 Micrometers (PM-2.5) – 18.36 lbs/hr – 40.1 tpy, and Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs) – 2.1 lbs/hr – 9.3 tpy

The proposed net changes of maximum allowable air pollution emissions from this facility after modification have been estimated to be:

Carbon Monoxide (CO) 0.01 lbs/hr, 0.0 tons per year (tpy); Nitrogen Oxides (NOx) -2.7 lbs/hr, -0.7 tpy; Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) -0.21 lbs/hr, -0.1 tpy; NOx+VOC +0.62 lbs/hr +0.15 tpy, Sulfur Dioxide (SOX) +0.03 lbs/hr, +0.01 tpy; Total Suspended Particulate Matter (TSP) +0.0 lbs/hr, +0.1 tpy; Particulate Matter Less Than 10 Micrometers (PM-10) -0.2 lbs/hr, -0.1 tpy; Particulate Matter Less Than 2.5 Micrometers (PM-2.5) +0.05 lbs/hr, +0.0 tpy, and Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs) +0.0 lbs/hr, -0.0 tpy

Public Comment Procedure for Permit Application #0537-M1-RN1

The Program has made a preliminary determination that this facility will meet all applicable requirements under the federal Clean Air Act, the New Mexico Air Quality Control Act, and Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board Regulations. The Program will not take final action on the permit application until the Program receives and analyzes any additional details or information developed during the public comment period. Interested persons may submit written comments or request a public information hearing on Permit Application #0537-M1-RN1 by either email to ppuckett@cabq.gov or by delivering written information or a written request to the Albuquerque Environmental Health Department, Air Quality Program – Permitting Division, P.O. Box 1293, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87103. Comments will be accepted and considered if postmarked by November 4, 2018.

Written requests for a public information hearing must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. Comments must be based on the requirements of the applicable local, state, and federal air quality laws and regulations, including the Clean Air Act.
