


IMPROVING PLACE FROM PLANNING TO ZONING

The *ABC-Z Project* is a two-year initiative to update the Albuquerque/Bernalillo County Comprehensive Plan and create an Integrated Development Ordinance. The project will simplify the zoning and subdivision regulations in order to improve opportunities for economic development, create jobs, protect established neighborhoods, streamline the development review/approval process and promote more sustainable development.

Comp Plan - EPC Study Sessions & Hearings - "ABC to Z" includes a collaborative effort between the City of Albuquerque and Bernalillo County to update the Albuquerque/Bernalillo County Comprehensive Plan. Work began in February 2015, and there have been numerous community meetings since.

The next step is to submit the updated draft to the City's formal review and approval process. The City's Environmental Planning Commission (EPC) will hold two study sessions in July and two public hearings in August.

Staff will provide education and details about the Comp Plan to the EPC and the public at the study sessions. The public can provide comments to the EPC at the hearings.

IDO - Module 3 Public Review - Join the ABC-Z Project team as they host public meetings on Aug. 29 and 30 to review and gather feedback on the third module of the Integrated Development Ordinance. This meeting will go over the new module and allow time for Q&A and feedback. Attendees will also be able to view the module online and provide feedback after the meeting.
