Covenant Presbyterian Church (Agent, Forest Owens) requests a variance of 95 feet for a sign within 200 feet of a residential zone district for Lot 8E, Block 1, Covenant Presbyterian Church, located at 9315 Candelaria RD NE, zoned MX-L [Section 14-16-5-12(E)(5)(c)]

On the 19th day of May, 2020, Forest Owens, agent for property owner Covenant Presbyterian Church ("Applicant") appeared before the Zoning Hearing Examiner ("ZHE") requesting a variance of 95 feet for a sign within 200 feet of a residential zone district ("Application") upon the real property located at 9315 Candelaria RD NE ("Subject Property"). Below are the ZHE's findings of fact and decision:

FINDING:

1. Applicant is granted a deferral of this matter to allow Applicant to timely submit evidence that Applicant has timely provided all required notice.

DECISION:

DEFERRAL of the Application to be heard at the ZHE hearing at 9:00 a.m. on June 16, 2020.

APPEAL:

If you wish to appeal this decision, you must do so by June 18, 2020 pursuant to Section 14-16-6-4(U), of the Integrated Development Ordinance, you must demonstrate that you have legal standing to file an appeal as defined.

Successful applicants are reminded that other regulations of the City must be complied with, even after approval of a special exception is secured. This decision does not constitute approval of plans for a building permit. If your application is approved, bring this decision with you when you apply for any related building permit or occupation tax number. Approval of a conditional use or a variance application is void after one year from date of approval if the rights and privileges are granted, thereby have not been executed, or utilized.
