#### **Project Description:**

The ART project is a 9.6-mile center running bus rapid transit project down Central Avenue ART that will modify the existing roadway section to accommodate the center running BRT within the existing Central Avenue right-of-way (ROW). Referred to as Albuquerque Rapid Transit (ART), the project limits for the first phase of construction extend from the Central Avenue/Unser Boulevard intersection on the west side of the metropolitan area to the Central Avenue/Louisiana Boulevard intersection on the metropolitan area's east side. The corridor length is approximately 9.6 miles. As planned, the proposed ART alignment follows Central Avenue with the exception of the downtown area between 1st Street and 10th Street, where the route will follow Copper Avenue and Gold Avenue, parallel streets one block north and south of Central Avenue, respectively.

Twenty (20) ART stations will be individually created. The ART stations will utilize raised platforms to provide level boarding and alighting of all passengers. Off-board advanced ticket purchasing will increase the efficiency of the buses by reducing the amount of time the bus spends at each stop. The ART project also includes pedestrian improvements in line with the Great Streets
