

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION HEARING FOR PROPOSED AIR QUALITY CONSTRUCTION PERMIT  
APPLICATION #3131-M1  
FOR HONSTEIN OIL & DISTRIBUTING, LLC**

**When: Thursday, March 21, 2019 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.**

**Where: Mountain View Community Center, 201 Prosperity Ave SE, Albuquerque, NM 87105.**

The purpose of the hearing is to provide information and answer questions regarding the proposed Air Quality Construction Permit Application #3131-M1 for Honstein Oil & Distributing, LLC (Honstein Oil). The location was chosen to accommodate the significant public interest that has been expressed in this matter.

Honstein Oil has submitted an air quality construction permit application to the Air Quality Program (Program) of the City of Albuquerque Environmental Health Department to modify Construction Permit #3131. Honstein Oil is requesting to allow distribution of unleaded gasoline to their company vehicles, increase unleaded gasoline annual throughput from 250,000 gallons to 500,000 gallons, and relocate their Albuquerque Terminal permanently from 101 Anderson Ave. SE to 4020 Broadway SE. The owner of this facility is Honstein Oil, 11 Paseo Real, Santa Fe, NM 87507.

The facility is a gasoline distribution bulk plant with an annual unleaded gasoline throughput of 450,000 gallons along with dispensing fuel with an annual unleaded gasoline throughput of 50,000 gallons. The facility consists of one (1) aboveground 10,000 gallon gasoline storage tank and one (1) loading rack.

The maximum air pollution emissions to the atmosphere from this facility have been estimated to be: Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) – 83.7 lbs/hr – 5.29 tpy

Representatives for Honstein Oil will speak regarding the proposed Construction Permit Application. Program staff will be available to answer questions regarding the review process for air quality permits and the status of Honstein Oil Permit Application #3131-M1. The public will have an opportunity to voice concerns and submit data or arguments, orally or in writing, for the public record regarding the application. Those who wish to do so at the March 21, 2019 hearing should sign the registry upon their arrival at the hearing. A hearing officer will direct the proceedings and is authorized to limit the length of the testimony.

Program staff will consider relevant testimony and documentation submitted at the hearing before making a decision on the Construction Permit Application.
