

PUBLIC NOTICE

Construction Permit for Honstein Oil & Distributing, LLC

Honstein Oil & Distributing, LLC (Honstein Oil) has submitted an air quality construction permit application to modify Construction Permit #3131, to the Air Quality Program (Program) of the City of Albuquerque Environmental Health Department. Honstein Oil is requesting to allow distribution of unleaded gasoline to their company vehicles, increase unleaded gasoline annual throughput from 250,000 gallons to 500,000 gallons, and relocate their Albuquerque Terminal permanently from 101 Anderson Ave. SE to 4020 Broadway SE. The owner of this facility is Honstein Oil, 11 Paseo Real, Santa Fe, NM 87507. This application file has been assigned Construction Permit #3131-M1.

The facility is a gasoline distribution bulk plant with an annual unleaded gasoline throughput of 450,000 gallons along with dispensing fuel with an annual unleaded gasoline throughput of 50,000 gallons. The facility consists of one (1) aboveground 10,000 gallon gasoline storage tank and one (1) loading rack.

The maximum air pollution emissions to the atmosphere from this facility have been estimated to be:
Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) – 83.7 lbs/hr – 5.29 tpy

A copy of the permit application is available for inspection by the public at the Program offices. Interested persons may submit written comments and evidence, request a public information hearing, or both on the permit application to the Program. Comments will be accepted and considered if postmarked by the end of the public comment period on November 16, 2018. Formal action on the application will be reserved pending receipt and analysis of any additional details or information developed during the public comment period.

The Program shall hold a Public Information Hearing pursuant to 20.11.41.15 NMAC if the Director determines there is significant public interest and a significant air quality issue is involved.

The Program expects to issue, issue subject to conditions, or deny this application on or before January 7, 2019. Any person who does not participate in the permitting action will not receive notification of the Program's decision regarding the proposed permit, unless the person has delivered a written request for notice to the Program.
