

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION HEARING FOR PROPOSED AIR QUALITY CONSTRUCTION PERMIT
APPLICATION #3340
FOR NEW MEXICO TERMINAL SERVICES, LLC.**

A Public Information Hearing (hearing) will be held on Thursday, August 30, 2018 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Mountain View Community Center, 201 Prosperity Ave SE, Albuquerque, NM 87105. The purpose of the hearing is to provide information and answer questions regarding the proposed Air Quality Construction Permit Application #3340 for New Mexico Terminal Services, LLC. The location was chosen to accommodate the significant public interest that has been expressed in this matter.

New Mexico Terminal Services, LLC has submitted an air quality construction permit application to the Air Quality Program (Program) of the City of Albuquerque Environmental Health Department for a new permit. The permit is for a 400 tons/hr hot mix asphalt plant (HMA) to be located at 9615 Broadway Blvd. SE (Site Coordinates **UTMN 3,869,300m UTME 347,500m**) in Albuquerque, New Mexico. The owner of this facility is New Mexico Terminal Services, LLC., 9615 Broadway Blvd. SE, Albuquerque, NM 87105.

The facility is a portable HMA production plant with railcar unloading and truck loading operations, and with aggregate and recycled asphalt products (RAP) handling. The proposed facility will consist of one (1) hot mix drum, one (1) hot mix drum baghouse, six (6) cold feed bins, one (1) cold feed conveyor, one (1) cold feed scalping screen, one (1) cold feed pug mill, one (1) mineral filler silo, one (1) HMA RAP bin, three (3) HMA RAP screen conveyors, one (1) HMA RAP screen, one (1) HMA incline conveyor, one (1) fuel oil fired hot oil heater, one (1) RAP crusher plant crusher, one (1) RAP crusher plant conveyor, plant haul roads and aggregate/RAP storage piles.

The maximum air pollution emissions to the atmosphere from this facility have been estimated to be; Carbon Monoxide (CO) – 53.4 pounds per hour (lbs/hr) – 54.1 tons per year (tpy), Nitrogen Oxides (NOx) – 22.4 lbs/hr – 23.7 tpy, Sulfur Oxides (SOx) – 23.1 lbs/hr – 26.6 tpy, Total Suspended Particulates (TSP) – 26.1 lb/hr – 31.2 tpy, 10 Micron Particulate Matter (PM₁₀) – 13.5 lb/hr – 15.5 tpy, 2.5 Micron Particulate Matter (PM_{2.5}) – 10.1 lb/hr – 10.6 tpy, Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) – 20.1 lb/hr – 20.3 tpy, Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs) – 4.19 tpy

Representatives for New Mexico Terminal Services, LLC. will speak regarding the proposed Construction Permit Application. Program staff will be available to answer questions regarding the review process for air quality permits and the status of New Mexico Terminal Services, LLC Construction Permit Application #3340. The public will have an opportunity to voice concerns and submit data or arguments, orally or in writing, for the public record regarding the application. Those who wish to do so at the August 30, 2018 hearing should sign the registry upon their arrival at the hearing. A hearing officer will direct the proceedings and is authorized to limit the length of the testimony.

Program staff will consider relevant testimony and documentation submitted at the hearing before making a decision on the Construction Permit Application.
