## **LEGAL DESCRIPTION:**

For all or a portion of 4.8 acre portion of the following: All of Section 28, Township 11 North, Range 2 East.

On November 6, 2023, the Development Facilitation Team (DFT) administratively approved the above referenced application for the EPC Site Plan Final Sign-off based on the following Findings:

- The request is for a Major Amendment to a prior approved Site Development Plan for a water treatment facility located within Major Public Open Space. The subject site is located at 6641 81st Street NW between Molten Rock Road and 81st Street, and is zoned NR-PO-B.
- 2. On June 15, 2023 the Environmental Planning Commission (EPC) approved PR-2023-008617/ SI-2023-00866 - Site Plan – EPC, Major Amendment.
- 3. The Site Plan meets the EPC conditions. DFT staff coordinated with EPC staff on the request. EPC staff provided written correspondence stating the conditions were addressed.

Appeals should be submitted via email to <u>PLNDRS@CABQ.GOV</u> (if files are less than 9MB in size). Files larger than 9MB can be sent to <u>PLNDRS@CABQ.GOV</u> using <u>https://wetransfer.com</u>. A Non-Refundable filing fee will be calculated and you will receive instructions about paying the fee online.

You will receive notification if any person files an appeal. If there is no appeal, you can receive Building Permits at any time after the appeal deadline quoted above, provided all conditions imposed at the time of approval have been met. Applicants submitting for building permit prior to the completion of the appeal period do so at their own risk. Successful applicants are reminded that there may be other City regulations of the IDO that must be complied with, even after approval of the referenced application(s).
