## **LEGAL DESCRIPTION:**

For all or a portion of: LOTS 7 & 8 BLOCK 23, NM TOWN CO ORIGINAL TOWNSITE zoned MX-FB-UD, located at 214/216 GOLD AVE SW between 2nd and 3RD ST containing approximately 0.1830 acre(s). (K-14)

On December 21, 2022, the Development Review Board (DRB) held a public meeting concerning the above referenced application and approved the request, with delegation to Planning, based on the following Findings:

- 1. This request is to adjust the boundaries between two lots to create Lots 8-A, Block 23 and Lot 7-A, Block 23 of the New Mexico Town Company's Original Townsite of Albuquerque at 0.0864 acres and 0.0765 acres in size respectively.
- 2. The property is zoned MX-FB-UD. Future development must be consistent with the underlying zone district.
- 3. DRB Determinations were approved permitting the existing right-of-way width for Gold Avenue along the subject property; permitting the existing right-of-way width for an existing alley along the subject property; and permitting the existing sidewalk width for the sidewalk along Gold Avenue fronting the subject property.
- 4. The applicant provided the required notice as outlined in the IDO Table 6-1-1.

## Conditions:

- 1. Final sign-off is delegated to Planning for adding the DRB Determinations as notes onto the Plat.
- 2. The applicant will obtain final sign off from Planning by February 22, 2023 or the case may be scheduled for the next DRB hearing and could be denied per the DRB Rules of Procedure.

<u>APPEAL:</u> If you wish to appeal this decision, you must do so within 15 days of the DRB's decision or by **JANUARY 9, 2023.** The date of the DRB's decision is not included in the 15-day period for filing an appeal, and if the 15<sup>th</sup> day falls on a Saturday, Sunday or Holiday, the next working day is considered as the deadline for filing the appeal.

For more information regarding the appeal process, please refer to Section 14-16-6-4(U) of the Integrated Development Ordinance (IDO). Appeals should be submitted via email to <u>PLNDRS@CABQ.GOV</u> (if files are less than 9MB in size). For files larger than 9 MB in size, please send an email to <u>PLNDRS@cabq.gov</u> and request that staff send you a link via Smartfile to upload the files to. A Non-Refundable filing fee will be calculated and you will receive instructions about paying the fee online.

You will receive notification if any person files an appeal. If there is no appeal, you can receive Building Permits at any time after the appeal deadline quoted above, provided all conditions imposed at the time of approval have been met. Applicants submitting for building permit prior to the completion of the appeal period do so at their own risk. Successful applicants are reminded that there may be other City regulations of the IDO that must be complied with, even after approval of the referenced application(s).
