The Planning Department has an opening for a paid internship starting immediately. This intern will work with Long Range planners doing community planning throughout Albuquerque. If hired, you may also be asked to do other tasks related to City Leaders Academy, Current Planning, and/or Historic Preservation, based on your interests and our needs, so there is lots of good experience to be gained from this internship.

Candidates must be enrolled in classes that will culminate in a degree. Candidates must be willing and available to work 20 hours a week, Monday-Friday during normal working hours. We prefer that you set a regular weekly schedule, with the understanding that some weeks may need to be flexible to work with your class commitments. Assistance with public meetings and/or events in the evenings or on weekends may be requested as needed. Pay is \$10/hour for undergraduate students and \$14/hour for graduate students, non-negotiable, with no benefits.
